





CHALLENGES & OPPORTUNITIES

Higher education today faces an unprecedented array of challenges, reshaped by the global COVID-19 pandemic, evolving economic conditions, and significant societal shifts. Institutions are navigating a landscape marked by volatile enrollment patterns, intensified financial pressures, and a rapid shift toward digital learning environments. The enduring impacts of the pandemic, compounded by ongoing political instability and economic uncertainty, have profoundly influenced the priorities and operations of higher education. Amid these upheavals, the demographic landscape of campuses is transforming, emphasizing the need to serve a more diverse and often non-traditional student body. This shift demands innovative approaches in student services, curriculum development, and community engagement, challenging institutions to maintain public accountability and institutional resilience. Additionally, the growing demand for skilled trades careers reflects a critical pivot in educational preferences, underscoring the need for Chesapeake College to expand and innovate in our vocational training programs, ensuring they are aligned with the evolving job market and the diverse aspirations of our student population.

Chesapeake College is well-positioned to leverage its strengths such as affordability, a strategic location, and a strong reputation to enhance its educational offerings. Our alignment with local workforce demands now accounts for over 50% of noncredit FTE, highlighting our role in strengthening career pathways and fostering valuable partnerships. Additionally, the significant growth in online enrollment, with over 40% of students taking online courses exclusively and about 30% additional students engaging in a mix of online and face-to-face learning, demonstrates our capacity to meet the needs of a changing student demographic.

Marketing and branding initiatives are underway to refresh the College's image, attracting new student populations and reinforcing our status as a regional leader. Supported by the Maryland's Blueprint for Education Plan, our dual enrollment programs have grown to represent more than a third of our total enrollment, showcasing our alignment with state educational priorities. Moreover, securing grants for the development of trades programs and enhancing student support services underscores our commitment to strategic growth.

The demographic shifts in the 5-county region, including an increasingly diverse population, present further opportunities for enrollment expansion and community engagement.

Changing labor needs and interest in noncredit workforce development, job training, and skilled trades, evident after the pandemic, leads Chesapeake College to implement innovative strategies to provide these educational advancement opportunities.

Diversity in faculty and staff remains a critical area of focus, with 61% of students reporting exposure to diverse perspectives in their coursework, and only 70% of faculty and staff expressing satisfaction with the College's efforts toward diversity and intercultural competence. Enhancing the representation of our faculty and staff with the student body is essential for fostering an inclusive learning environment.



The success of students in online courses is also a pivotal concern, as identified in the Completion Project findings from student focus groups. Strategies to enhance the quality and satisfaction of online learning are crucial. Moreover, only 22% of our students are Pell eligible, underscoring the need to increase scholarship availability and financial aid utilization.

Chesapeake College also contends with competition from four-year institutions, requiring a clear emphasis on our unique strengths and value propositions. Location-specific challenges such as limited internet access and a smaller workforce in certain areas necessitate creative solutions to connect students with resources and opportunities.

Finally, a projected 10% decline in high school enrollment over the next five years demands innovative recruitment strategies to attract future generations.

As we prepare to navigate these complexities, Chesapeake College's strategic plan is heavily informed by data-driven insights, aiming to craft a forward-looking strategy that addresses both the immediate challenges and sets a robust foundation for future growth and success. By focusing on these strategic areas, Chesapeake College will continue to serve as a pivotal educational pillar in the community, adaptable and responsive to the ever-changing educational landscape.


